### John Bear's Nursery Who We All Are

We are very fortunate that for many of the children there has been continuity of staffing with Mrs Godbold as our morning nursery teacher and Mrs Athill taking that role in the afternoons. Also Mrs Howes still works alongside them as our teaching assistant from Monday to Thursday, with Miss Garrard supporting the children at lunch time each day and on a Wednesday, Thursday and Friday morning.

Ms Firth is our Nursery Manager and she will be at nursery everyday from 10.15am until nursery closes at 6.15 pm. Miss Seals is our Deputy Manager and she is at nursery everyday from 7.15 am until 3.15 pm. Miss Riches is our new teaching assistant in the nursery and she works everyday from 12.45pm until nursery closes and is also around on a Friday morning. Finally we welcome Mrs Nutt as our nursery administrator and she is in the office everyday from 8.45am until 3.15pm to answer all your nursery questions. We do hope that you will make all our new members of staff feel welcomed and please be patient while they learn new things.

## Planning In the Moment

Since September we have adopted a new way of working in the Nursery called 'planning in the moment'. It is based on the work of Anna Ephgrave and both Mrs Godbold and Mrs Howes attended some training with her before the summer holidays.

Rather than planning activities for the children in which the adult takes the lead, in 'planning in the moment' the adult watches the children's play, identifies how to move the child's skills or learning on and then supports them to do this in that moment. As a result the teaching is more closely matched to the children's individual needs and interests.

As part of our 'planning in the moment', each week we have a number of children whose play and learning we focus on in particular. You will be given a letter the week before and invited to tell us more about your child's interests and learning at home. It is also an opportunity for you to ask us about anything you would like to know about their progress and development. Your child's key worker will also arrange to meet with you after your child's focus week to discuss what has been observed and answer any questions you may have.

All the children also have their Learning Journey in which we record their many achievements with observations and photographs.

## Lunches

We seem to be getting the hang of lunches now, with lunch boxes going on the trolleys in the foyer and hot dinners being booked in advance via Mrs Nutt.

Please can you not put any nuts in the children's lunch boxes as they can be a choking hazard, but also because of potential allergies.

Also if you include grapes in their lunches, please can you cut them in half because whole they can also be a choking hazard.

## Breakfast and Tea Club

At John Bear's Nursery we also run a breakfast and tea club which is proving to be both useful to parents and popular with the children. It is available to all children from the nursery and John of Gaunt School.

Breakfast Club starts at 7.30am through to 9.00am with a range of breakfast foods on offer. The children from John of Gaunt are accompanied down to school for the start of their school day.

Tea Club 1 starts as soon as nursery and school finishes and again the children from school are accompanied up to the Nursery by an adult. There is a small snack available for all the children at about 3.30pm.

Tea Club 2 starts at 4.30pm and runs through until 6.00pm. There is a more substantial snack at about 5.00pm. Children joining us at the end of after school clubs are again accompanied by an adult up to the Nursery.

## Open Event at John of Gaunt School

On Friday 8th November there is an Open Event at John of Gaunt. From 9.45am until 10.15am there is an opportunity to see the school in action with an informal tour. There is then a formal open evening from 5.30pm until 6.30pm with curriculum taster activities for prospective pupils and parents, which also includes a talk by the Head of School at 6.00pm.

## Gates

Please note that the gates will all be open everyday until 9.15 am to allow parents to go out towards Norwich Road or come back through to Hungate Street. However, nursery afternoon parents you will need to access the nursery only from the Norwich Road side as the gates will be locked to ensure the safety of our main school children. These will then be opened again just before 3.00 pm. Please feel able to come and remind us though as we sometimes forget.

## In the Air

On Tuesday 23rd October we are holding a holiday club activity day at John Bear's Nursery based on the theme of 'In the Air'. We will be exploring a range of STEM activities like kite making, parachutes and balloon tennis.

## Nursery and School Photos

## Spare Clothes and Wellies

Thank you for bringing in a pair of wellies for your child to use as outdoor shoes. They are all becoming increasingly independent about changing them.

We have been very lucky with the weather so far but as we encourage the children to explore outside in most weathers, please can you make sure that your child comes with appropriate clothes for going outside.

We also require all the children to have a spare set of clothes in a small bag on their peg which will need to be replenished when used, and again appropriate for the time of year.

Please can you name all items of clothing and footwear.
