<p>The little girl in the story had fun making and decorating her paper dolls. Have a go at making your own. What names will you give to yours? Can you make some numbers to order at home?</p>	<p>For those of you who have signed up for the Virtual Big Sing, we hope you are enjoying practising the songs and dances. The big event takes place this Friday the 19th at 2 PM so please check your emails for a link to the stream on the day and instructions on how to tune in. We are hoping to join in with some of the children at nursery that day too.</p>
<p>Learning to use scissors takes practise. Ask your adult to draw some straight, wavy and zig zag lines across a piece of paper and have a go at cutting along these lines. You could also have a try at cutting around some shapes or pictures, sticking them down and making a picture with them.</p>	<p>At the end of the story the little girl grew up into an adult. How have you changed from when you were a baby? What can you do now that you couldn't do then? Ask your adult to show you some pictures of them from when they were a baby and as they grew up, how have they changed?</p>	<p>In our story the paper dolls are all in a line next to each other.
