Nursery activities

Water bottles

The children are continuing to enjoy exploring outside in all weathers and we would love this to continue even as it inevitably gets colder and more muddy outside. Please can you therefore make sure that your child comes with appropriate clothes for going outside and bring in either a pair of waterproof trousers, a set of waterproofs or an all-in-one for your child to wear outside when they are exploring.

Thank you to those of you who have sent in a spare set of clothes to leave on your child's peg. Please can you make sure this is at least one whole set of clothes, including socks, and also ensure that you replenish these when they have been sent home to wash.

Most of you have now activated your Tapestry account and have hopefully been enjoying sharing the observations of your children. If you have not been able to do this yet then please do this by going to the email you received or let us know if you are having any difficulties with access. Thank you to those of you who have already added photos or news from home. We really enjoy seeing what the children have been up to.

Also, when collecting your child from the main door, please can you wait behind the stop line.
