### Christmas Party

If your child doesn't usually attend on a Tuesday you are still very welcome to bring them for 10.30 am and then collect them again at 12.00.

### Christmas Sing Song

We are really hoping that we can perform a Christmas Sing Song for you all this year so have set some dates (see above), but they will be subject to Covid Guidelines at the time.

If your child does not usually attend either of the sessions then you are very welcome to bring them along to one of the Sing Songs so that they can join in.

Please note that there is a limit of two adults per child.

## Lunches

Please can you not put any nuts in the children's lunch boxes as they can be a choking hazard, but also because of potential allergies. Whole grapes are also a choking hazard so please can you cut them in half. We would also be grateful if you could not put sweets or chocolate bars in there too. And if your child needs cutlery to eat their lunch, please can you include that too. Thank you.

## Water bottles

It is great to encourage the children to drink water throughout the day from their water bottles and they also enjoy their milk at snack time.  
If possible, please can you only send water in their bottles. If your child really won't drink water, please make sure that you send in squash of a very weak strength.

## Wellies, Waterproofs and Spare Clothes

Thank you for bringing in a pair of wellies for your child to use as outdoor shoes. They are all becoming increasingly independent about changing them.  
We have been very lucky with the weather so far but as we encourage the children to explore outside in most weathers, please can you make sure that your child comes with appropriate clothes for going outside.  
We also require all the children to have at least one spare set of clothes in a small bag on their peg which will need to be replenished when used, and again appropriate for the time of year.
