## Foodbank

As we all battle through this cost of living crisis, where we see the price of everything rising, we are acutely aware that for some people this may have a significant impact.

I just wanted everyone to be aware that we as a school are a food bank partner and as such I am able to issue foodbank vouchers. St Michael's church is our closest food bank centre and we are very fortunate that they are able to make a delivery of food parcels if this is necessary.

Please tell someone if you are currently struggling and feel that maybe a food parcel will get you to the end of the month or just support a temporary blip. There is no judgement made ever and we are more than happy to help as are the foodbank centres.

You can either come directly to Mrs Toplis or speak to Mrs Seal, Mrs Lord or your child's class teacher and the information will be passed on in confidence.

We are going to use our Harvest Assembly this year to make a collection to support the foodbank so that they can continue to offer their amazing service. More details about this to follow.



## Parents Evening

This year, we will once again be using school cloud parents evening. Although times have changed slightly with regards to the pandemic, we actually felt that school cloud was a successful way to run parents evenings and meant that we could update you on your child's progress without the added complication of attending school. It also means that we run exactly to time!

For those new to this we will send out details nearer the time but in short you are invited via email to book a time with your child's class teacher, you then receive an email confirming your time and at the bottom of that email there is a link to click on at your allotted time where you will then link virtually to your child's class teacher. Appointments are set at 10 minutes and the system ends them after this time, hence why teachers always run to time!

Our Autumn Term Parents evenings will be on **Monday 14th November, Tuesday 15th November** and **Wednesday 16th November** for your diaries but an email inviting you to book an appointment will be sent out in due course.



## Maths Workshops

Mrs Simpson will be running a series of Maths workshops for all year groups to let you know how Maths is taught at John of Gaunt and to help you to support your child at home.

We are very aware that Maths is now taught very differently from when many of you were at school yourselves and we would like to share how we teach it now so that when your child tells you how it's done you are not surprised.

We promise that it is a supportive session and not one where you will be asked really hard Maths questions or put on the spot!

The sessions will start with information and then the children will come into the hall so that you can work with your child on some maths games and activities.
